Licensing Procedure for SPECTRUM LICENCE



Introduction

The National Communications Authority (NCA) is responsible for regulating telecommunications, broadcasting, in Somalia. In addition, NCA controls country's frequency spectrum.

Every telecommunication or broadcast operator in Somalia should seek to get license from the NCA. The NCA issues annual commercial license on a first come first served basis. The licensees are allowed to built network infrastructure and/or provide services to third parties in accordance with license terms and conditions.

Licensing Requirements

The licensing process starts with the submission of a duly completed application form.

Generally speaking, all applicants for commercial licenses should meet the following conditions:

- Be registered in Somalia with the National Communications Authority (NCA) as telecommunication, broadcast or other service provider Company.
- Have a duly registered office and permanent premises in Somalia,
- Provide company profile which provides detailed information of company shareholders and directors,
